

What is the Adopt-A-Street Program?

The Adopt-A-Street Program is a litter-reduction campaign designed to remove litter and debris from City roads and improve the quality of our environment. The program offers individuals, groups and businesses the opportunity to demonstrate their desire for a cleaner community by taking responsibility for streets, which they can help beautify and keep litter free.

How is a street selected for adoption?

Volunteer groups have the option of selecting a street where litter is visible. It may be any City street , a commercial thoroughfare or a road through a sparsely populated area. The City of Murrieta can also help select a street.

How does the program work?

Litter visible along a street creates a poor image of the City. Litter pollutes the community's environment and tends to lower the quality of life of its citizens. Participation in the City Adopt-A-Street program will help the City save Public Works man-hours, which saves tax dollars that can be used towards other activities, such as road repair and improvement, to enhance the community's quality of life. The cleaner environment will generate civic pride and encourage residents and visitors alike not to litter.

What are the requirements?

- Pick-up litter and debris in the City approved right-of-way.
- Remove weeds in the approved right-of-way.
- Participants will be 18 years of age or older unless prior approval is granted.
- Filled trash bags will be placed at designated locations for pickup and disposal.

- Wear safety equipment at all times when at approved location.
- Participants will sign a hold harmless agreement prior to their participation. A parent or legal guardian must sign for a minor.

How long is the adopted street?

Volunteers agree to remove litter and weeds along the one-mile of City right-of-way a minimum of four times a year for a two-year period. Volunteers receive operating supplies, two installed Adopt-A-Street signs announcing sponsorship, the opportunity to contribute to community beautification and recognition for a job well done.



How will a volunteer be recognized for adopting a street?

Once an Adopt-A-Street application has been approved and agreement signed, the first clean-up activity is scheduled. Upon completion of the clean-up, City staff will install Adopt-A-Street signs announcing the program participation.
